The Theological Imperative to Authenticity Dec 29 2020 From a theological viewpoint, this book explores the junction between the philosophical existential idea of the authentic self and its cultural appropriation. The Healthcare Imperative Aug 05 2021 The United States has the highest per capita spending on health care of any industrialized nation but continually lags behind other nations in health care outcomes including life expectancy and infant mortality.
