"What Valeriano and Maness provide in this book is an empirically-grounded discussion of the reality of cyber conflict, based on an analysis of cyber incidents and disputes experienced by international states since 2001. They delineate patterns of cyber conflict to develop a larger theory of cyber

It is often assumed that social movements, such as that of labour, will simply be overwhelmed by the changes brought about by globalisation.
