However, the exam has grown increasingly 'community-orientated' and has become the Diploma which future community and junior paediatricians visiting from abroad take, when they want an easier and quicker qualification. GPs too are taking the Diploma in order to become qualified. This book is carefully targeted to cover all aspects of the exam with appropriate emphasis on community problems.
