Following each chapter is a close reading of work by writers as varied as Rudyard Kipling, Colleen Thibaudeau, Adrienne Rich, and Lyn Hejinian. These readings provide practical applications of nonsense theory and establish the interdependence of theory and practice. Nonsense inhabits and challenges traditional forms simultaneously; in *Touch Monkeys* Parsons enters into the spirit of the genre. Mama's out dancing, and Lulu, the babysitter, is in charge.
